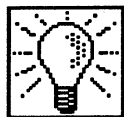
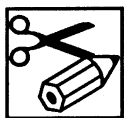


My Neighborhood

- Tell the student—"You are standing at Second Avenue and Center Street facing North Park." Answer the questions below orally.

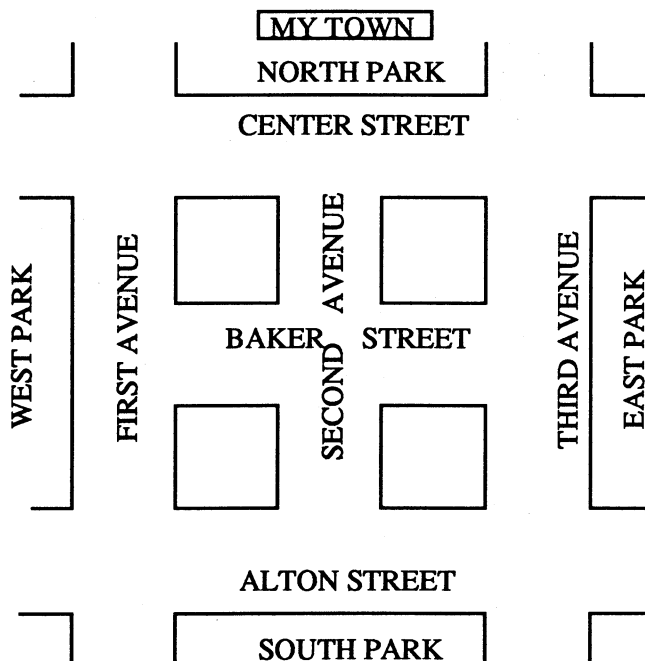


1. What street or avenue is one block to your right?

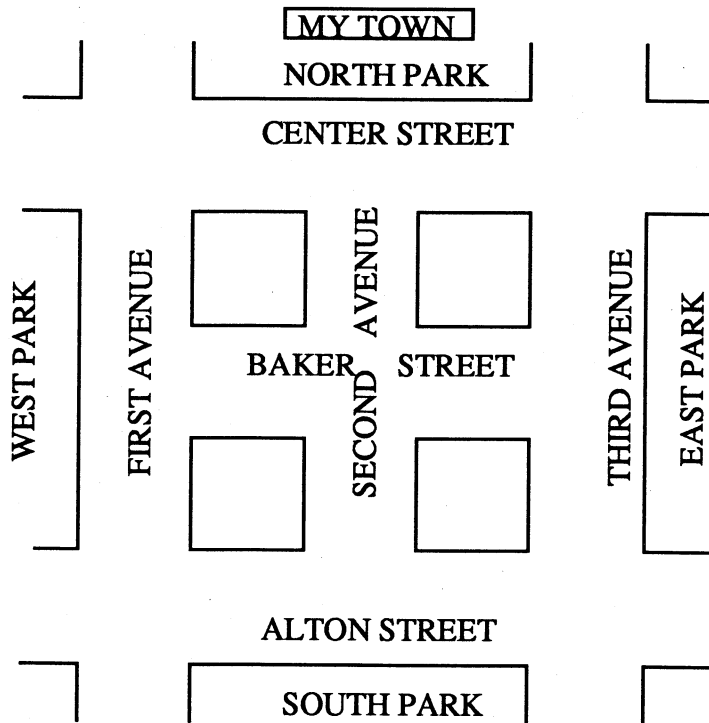
